Imagine being on the street with no way to identify yourself and no means to get replacement documents. Relapsing after 6 sober years, Laurie lost her housing and has been living on the street. Inevitably for those without housing, her documents were stolen, leaving her unable to gain employment or apply for housing. Working with one of our Program Specialists, Laurie was able to get a replacement State ID and birth certificate.



As Laurie works to maintain her sobriety and rebuild her life, she understands the critical importance of an ID and she will use our document storage and SafeWallet programs to secure her documents. With that barrier removed, and with help from many other agencies, Laurie has the resources to move her life forward.

Social Return on Investment

\$5.5 MIL



For less than \$100,000, Homeless ID Project saved the community an estimated \$5.5 million. That's a return of \$60 for every dollar invested.

\$94,595

Q1 expenses of \$94,595 generated 1,893 documents. If only 10% of docs end a neighbor's homelessness, the community will save an estimated \$5.58 million. This is a return of \$58.99 per \$1 of expense. $(1,893 \times 10\% \times \$30,000 = \$5,580,000 / \$94,595 = \$58.99)$
